### **NMMI offers a variety of merit-based and need-based scholarships.**

In our college program, approximately 85 percent of NMMI students receive either federal or scholarship assistance totaling nearly 1.8 million dollars.

In both schools there are many institutional merit-based and need-based scholarships available to qualified students.

**Approximately 90% of all students eligible for scholarship assistance receive an award. Scholarship assistance ranges from \$150.00 to \$10,000.**

### **Financial Aid for High School**

NMMI offers a variety of merit-based and need-based scholarships. However, no federal aid programs are available for high school students. When a student applies for admission to NMMI the Formal Application includes an area for scholarship information. This information will be the basis for scholarship evaluation. Students will be given the opportunity to update the information yearly.

### **Financial Aid for Junior College**

NMMI offers federal financial aid to all eligible college students. Federal funds are limited by law to college students. The application priority date is May 1; assistance is awarded after this date depending on availability of funds. NMMI scholarship opportunities are also available for college students.
